Regulations Governing the Incentives for Faculty Guidance on Student Participation in the National Science and Technology Council's Undergraduate Research Projects

- Article 1 To encourage faculty at Kaohsiung Medical University (hereinafter "KMU") to guide students in applying for and executing the National Science and Technology Council's (hereinafter "NSTC") undergraduate research projects, thereby facilitating students' early engagement in research training, learning research methods, and strengthening experimental and practical skills, Regulations Governing the Incentives for Faculty Guidance on Student Participation in the National Science and Technology Council's Undergraduate Research Projects (hereinafter "the Regulations") are hereby established.
- Article 2 The recipients of the incentives under the Regulations are KMU faculty members who guide students receiving grants from NSTC's "Undergraduate Research Projects," based on the list officially announced by NSTC for the current year.
- Article 3 Those who meet the requirements of the preceding paragraph shall be awarded a grant of thirty thousand New Taiwan Dollars (NTD 30,000) per case. The grant may be used to cover research-related expenses, including but not limited to the publication of papers, pharmaceutical supplies, experimental animals, and stationery and miscellaneous expenses. The grant shall be reimbursed by the project principal investigator with attached relevant documents after the research results report is submitted.
- Article 4 The funding for the incentives stipulated in the Regulations is provided by the Ministry of Education to support the school affairs development plan of private universities and colleges.
- Article 5 After being reviewed and passed by the Administrative Meeting, the Regulations shall be implemented from the date of announcement, and the same applies to amendments.
